

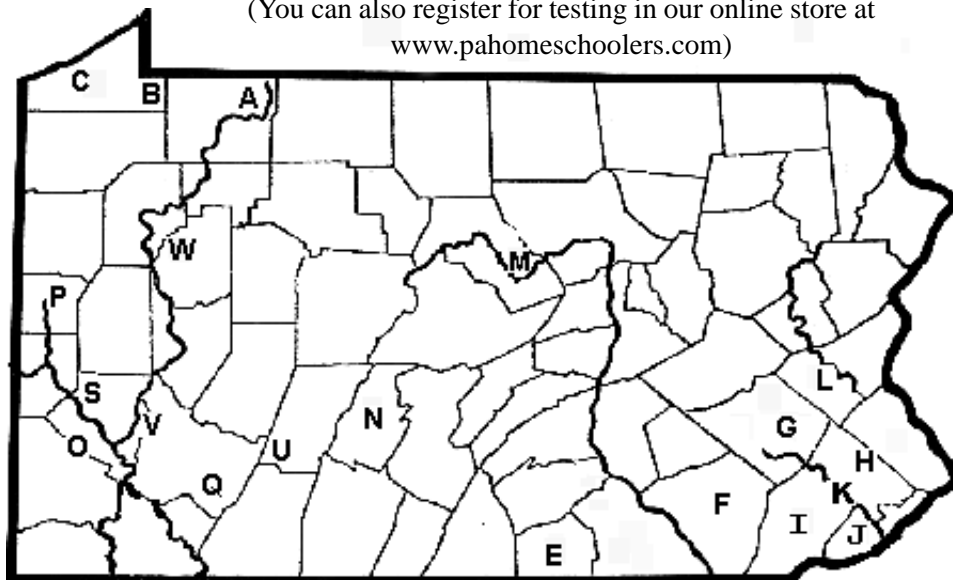

 (Parents who don't want their children to take the Science and Social Studies tests, which are not required by PA law, may pick their children up at 12:00, but there will be no discount.)

Cost: only \$30 per child if you preregister. \$35 per child at the door.

Who can Participate: Any homeschooled children 3rd grade through 12th grade.

Why Fall Testing? Fall testing using the TerraNova fulfills the testing requirement for 3rd, 5th, and 8th graders in the homeschooling law. If your child scores well you can relax. If your child doesn't score well, you can work extra hard in the weak subject areas and your evaluator can point out your child's progress in that area in your end-of-year evaluation. Fall tests are not harder since children take the test that is usually given at the end of the previous grade. You can also test just to follow your child's progress from year to year.

How Can I Prepare My Child? You can order the *Scoring High on the TerraNova* test preparation materials (\$8.95 plus tax for student workbooks, \$14.95 plus tax for

teachers' manuals). Level 2 is for 3rd grade, 4 is for 5th, 7 is for 8th. (We have all levels from 1 to 8.) We buy back used teachers' manuals for \$6 at the test site.

Out of Level Testing Option. If your child is either working above or below grade level, we allow out-of-level testing. Instead of putting his or her actual grade level under "GRADE" when you register, put the grade level of work that he or she is now beginning. Then at the door, ask us to norm the test for the child's actual grade as well.

How to Preregister: Send this form in, postmarked by **Oct. 8**, or register in the online store at www.pahomeschoolers.com by **Oct. 10**. We will send you test site directions, which can also be found online.
